
# Halloween pattern - skulls

Technique: krokbragd / boundweave

## Warping scheme




### Warping

- Warp H1 as heddled layer
- Warp H2, H3 and H4 as unheddled layer

## Putting the unheddled threads in the right order

- Put H2, H3 and H4 on popsickle sticks in the order as drawn in the warping scheme, so the first thread on H3, the second on H2 and the third on H4. Make separate heddle sets.
- The orange threads for the borders runs through two heddle sets, so the first orange thread through H1 and H3 and the second one through H2 and H4 (indicated by the \* in the warping scheme).



## Weaving

The weaving sequence is H1 - H2 - H3 - H2 - H1 - H4. Repeat this.
